With that, hundreds of us skateboarders descended upon Broadway and shut the streets down.



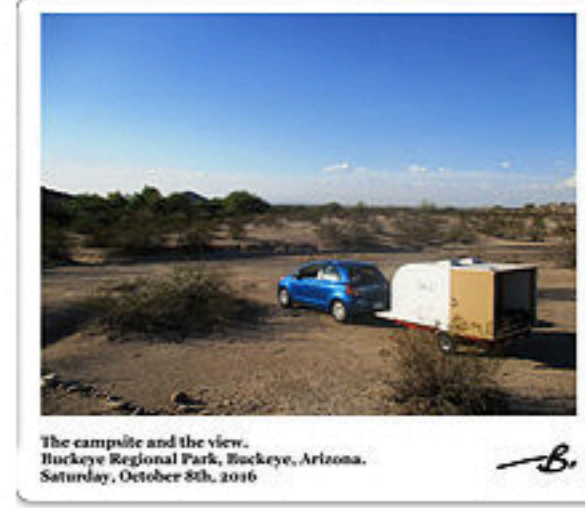
